

# CCA Identification Process of At-Risk Students

## Highest Priority Students: Returning Dropouts

Students in grades 7-12 who have dropped out of school and are not reenrolling in the district.

## Other Students: Potential Dropouts

Must meet a minimum of 2 Domains.

### Domain 1: Attendance

- Students who attend less than 89% of the school year

### Domain 2: Academics

- Students who have been retained in elementary or middle school
- Students who have failed any classes
- Students in high school who are over age but under credited

### Domain 3: Proficiency on District Wide Assessments

- Scores on District Wide Assessments that are 2.0 grade levels or more below peers in reading or math

### Domain 4: No School Connection

- Students who are/have been expelled
- Students who have been suspended for 3 or more days
- Students who have moved multiple times during the year
- Students who have reported being bullied/harassed
- Students with more than 3 office referrals in the last month
- Students who returned/transitioned back from placement setting
- Students who do not participate in school activities
